

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- Membership becomes final by vote of the Temple Board of Trustees. New members will be notified in writing following the vote of the Board. Board meetings are generally held the third Thursday of each month.
- You are responsible for all monthly dues through and including the month that you submit your written resignation to the Temple Board of Trustees. You are liable for religious school tuition regardless of when you resign from the Temple or withdraw your child(ren) from the school.
- The Temple asks prospective new members to enclose a payment equaling two (2) months of dues and fees when submitting this application.

### **B'nai Israel Reform Temple Dues Structure**

Effective July 1, 2023

## **Category Descriptions**

**Full (couple)** is a membership where both adults cannot qualify for any of the types listed below.

<u>Under Age 35</u> an individual or couple who both are under age thirty-five. This type of membership shall terminate on the first day of the month that the individual, or either member of the couple, reaches the age of thirty-five. Membership in this category shall not exceed a period of three years.

Individual (not retired) a member who is not retired and is not eligible for "under the age 35" category.

**<u>Retired Couple</u>** a couple who (1) are both retired, or no longer gainfully and actively employed, and (2) both members have reached the age of sixty-two, or have reached the age of fifty-five and been a member for five years or more.

**<u>Retired Individual</u>** an individual who (1) has retired, or is no longer gainfully and actively employed, and (2) has reached the age of sixty-two, or has reached the age of fifty-five and been a member for five years or more.

## **Fee Explanations**

**Building Fund:** The Building Fund levy of \$600.00 is due upon joining the Temple or you may choose to spread the payment of the levy over four years. However, the levy must be paid in full prior to your first Bar or Bat Mitzvah celebration or your resignation.

**General Fund Assessment:** This fee is evaluated on a regular basis and will remain in effect unless changed by the Board of Trustees with approval of the Congregation.

**Religious School:** Religious School tuition is due at registration. It is in addition to your membership dues, fees, and assessments.
